

Not sure where to start? Try the following tips:





After choosing a head shape template:


- Lightly draw a horizontal line from the tops of the ears across the face. This is where the eyes will go!
- Lightly draw a vertical line down the middle of the face. This is where the center of the nose and lips will go!


If you would like extra support breaking down a drawing into manageable chunks, consider using the grid method:


- Click here to learn more about the <u>grid</u> <u>method</u>.
- Using the grid method means having a physical photo of the drawing subject to use as a reference image. If using this method, make sure children have photos available.
- If using stable, flat mirrors for drawing selves, the grid method can be replicated on a mirror using tape!















