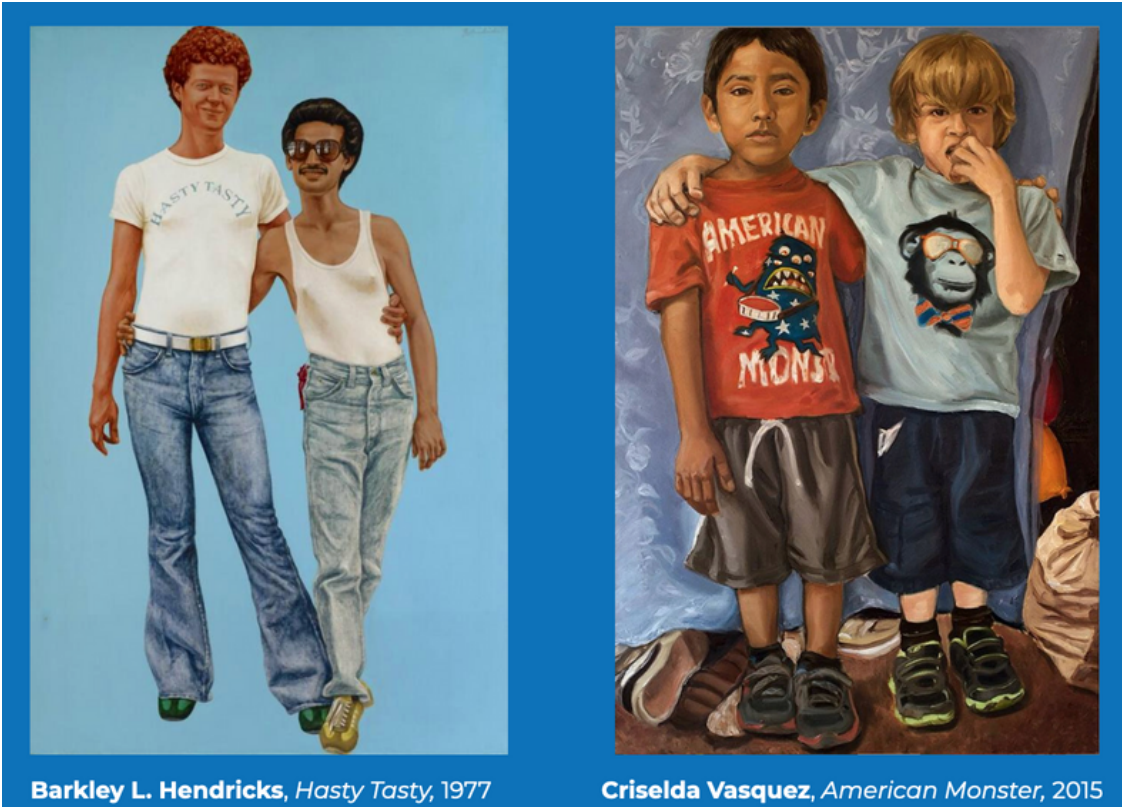

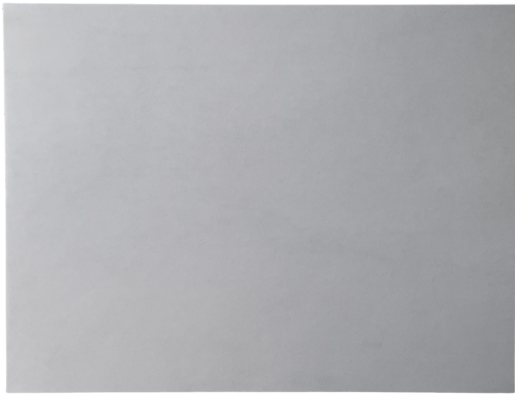

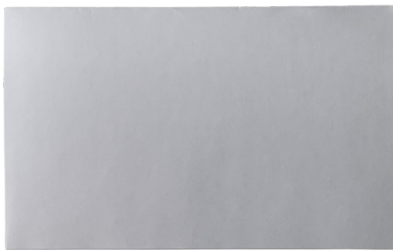
MAKING A 4-PAGE PORTRAIT BOOKLET

3: Turn the paper sideways.

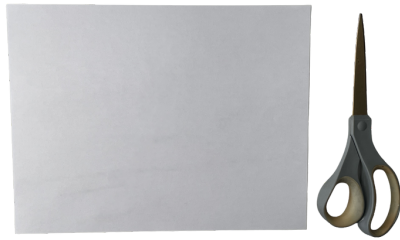


4: Fold the paper in half (the short way).

2: Fold paper in half the short way.



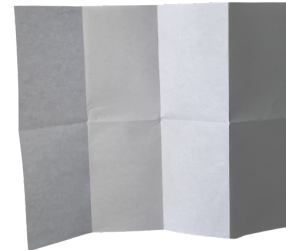
3: Fold paper in half the long way.



4: Turn the paper sideways.



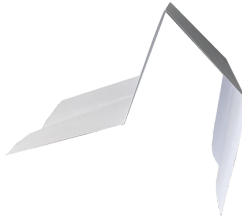
5: Fold paper in half the short way.



6: Unfold your entire paper.



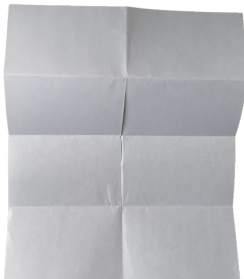
7: Fold your paper the short way.



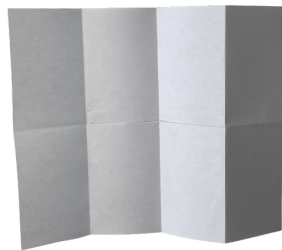
8: Flip paper to make a tent.



9: Cut from the top down to the middle.



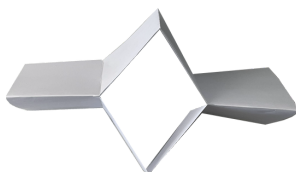
10: Unfold your entire paper.
